→ Section 1. KRS 12.020 is amended to read as follows:

4 Departments, program cabinets and their departments, and the respective major 5 administrative bodies that they include are enumerated in this section. It is not intended 6 that this enumeration of administrative bodies be all-inclusive. 11		functions of the cabinet and its employees and shall be responsible for carrying out
12		the programs and policies of the cabinet. The secretary shall be the chief executive

22	(4)	The secretary of the Education and Workforce Development Cabinet and the
23		secretary's designated representatives, in the discharge of the duties of the secretary,
24		may administer oaths and affirmations, take depositions, certify official acts, and
25		issue subpoenas to compel the attendance of witnesses and production of books,
26		papers, correspondence, memoranda, and other records considered necessary and

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- 2 (5) The secretary of the Education and Workforce Development Cabinet may delegate
 3 any duties of the secretary's office to employees of the cabinet as he or she deems

- 13 The Early Childhood Advisory Council is established as a public agency and (1)14 political subdivision of the Commonwealth with all powers, duties, and 15 responsibilities conferred upon it by statute and essential to perform its functions 16 including but not limited to employing other persons, consultants, attorneys, and 17 agents. The council shall be attached to the [Office of the Governor]Education and 18 Workforce Development Cabinet for administrative purposes and shall establish 19 necessary advisory councils. The secretary of the Education and Workforce 20 Development Cabinet or the secretary's designee shall be the appointing authority 21 for the council pursuant to KRS Chapter 18A. The council shall have the ability to 22 make expenditures from the early childhood development fund and shall ensure that 23 expenditures made from the early childhood development fund are in conformance 24 with its duties as established by the General Assembly.

3		broad constituencies of Kentucky's early childhood development community.
4	(7)	The council shall meet at least quarterly and at other times upon call of the chair or
5		a majority of the council.
6	(8)	Members of the council shall serve on a voluntary basis and be reimbursed for their
7		expenses in accordance with state travel expense and reimbursement administrative
8		regulations.
