1	AN ACT relating to transient public school students.
2	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:
3	→SECTION 1. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 158 IS CREATED TO
4	READ AS FOLLOWS:
5	(1) For purposes of this section, "eligible student" shall mean a public school
6	student enrolled in grade one (1), two (2), or three (3) who qualifies for free or
7	reduced-price school meals or attends a school that participates in the community
8	eligibility provision of the National School Lunch Program.
9	(2) When an eligible student changes his or her residence during the school year and
10	the change in residence results in the student being assigned to a different school
11	within the same school district, the parent or guardian of the eligible student
12	shall have the option to request the student remain enrolled in the original
13	<u>school.</u>
14	(3) (a) Notwithstanding KRS 158.110, if the student remains enrolled in the
15	original school, the school district shall provide transportation to the
16	original school from the student's new residence, except as provided in
17	paragraph (b) of this subsection.
18	(b) The superintendent may deny the transportation request if he or she
19	determines the distance and travel time that the student would spend in
20	transport is impracticable. The district shall report the transportation denial
21	and supporting rationale to the Kentucky Department of Education.
