- 3 → SECTION 1. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 158 IS CREATED TO

- 5 No social studies curriculum adopted by a superintendent shall reflect content-based
- 6 censorship of:
- 7 (1) The historical oppression of a particular group of people based on race, ethnicity,
- 8 <u>class, nationality, religion, sexual orientation, or geographic region;</u>
- 9 (2) Controversial aspects of history;
- 10 (3) The history of an ethnic group; or
- 11 (4) Historical documents relevant to subsections (1), (2), and (3) of this section.
- 12 → SECTION 2. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 158 IS CREATED TO
- 13 READ AS FOLLOWS:
- 14 Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, a school or school district may adopt,
- implement, and offer equity, diversity, and inclusion curricula, programs, initiatives,
- 16 *and instruction without penalty.*
- → SECTION 3. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 164 IS CREATED TO
- 18 READ AS FOLLOWS:
- 19 Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, public postsecondary education
- 20 <u>institutions may adopt, implement, and offer diversity, equity, and inclusion programs,</u>
- 21 <u>initiatives, and instruction without penalty.</u>
