1	AN ACT relating to terrorist activity and declaring an emergency.
2	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:
3	→SECTION 1. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 158 IS CREATED TO
4	READ AS FOLLOWS:
5	(1) As used in this section:
6	(a) "Antisemitism" means hostility toward or discrimination against Jews as a
7	religious, ethnic, or racial group;
8	(b) "Designated terrorist organization" means an organization that has been
9	designated as a terrorist organization under the Immigration and
10	Nationality Act, 8 U.S.C. sec. 1189;
11	(c) "Material support or resources" has the same meaning as in 18 U.S.C. sec.
12	<u>2339A; and</u>
13	(d) "School" means a public school or public charter school located in
14	Kentucky.
15	(2) All school districts, public schools, and public charter schools shall act to protect
16	Jewish students from credible threats of violence or violence motivated by
17	antisemitism.
18	(3) (a) A school district, public school, public charter school, or student
19	organization affiliated with a public school or public charter school shall
20	not provide material support or resources to a designated terrorist
21	organization.
22	(b) If a school determines that an affiliated student organization has provided
23	material support or resources to a designated terrorist organization, the
24	school shall submit a report to the proper law enforcement authorities and
25	the school shall defund and disband the student organization.
26	→SECTION 2. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 164 IS CREATED TO
27	READ AS FOLLOWS:

1	(1) As used in this section:
2	(a) "Antisemitism" means hostility toward or discrimination against Jews as a

4	(b) "Designated terrorist organization" means an organization that has been

7	(c) "Institution" means a public postsecondary education institution and
8	includes all programs, departments, divisions, offices, centers, colleges,
9	student governments, and any individual acting in an official capacity on

11	(d) "Material support or resources" has the same meaning as in 18 U.S.C. sec.
12	2339A; and
13	(e) "Public funds" has the same meaning as in KRS 446.010.
14	(2) An institution shall act to protect its Jewish students from credible threats of
15	violence or violence motivated by antisemitism.
16	(3) An institution or student or faculty organization registered by or affiliated with
17	the institution shall not provide material support or resources to a designated
18	terrorist organization. If an institution determines that material support or
19	resources have been provided to a designated terrorist organization, the
20	institution shall:
21	(a) Submit a report to the proper law enforcement authorities; and
22	(b) If the material support or resources were provided by a student or faculty
23	organization, defund the student or faculty organization and terminate its
24	registration or affiliation with the institution.
25	→SECTION 3. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 61 IS CREATED TO
26	READ AS FOLLOWS:
27	(1) As used in this section, "antisemitism" means hostility toward or discrimination

1	against Jews as a religious, ethnic, or racial group.
2	(2) In addition to considerations of unlawful discrimination on the basis of race
3	religion, or natural origin, if there is an allegation that an unlawfu
4	discriminatory practice or conduct is targeting an individual or group based on
5	any actual or perceived connection to any aspect of Jewish identity, a law
6	enforcement officer shall also consider whether the alleged unlawfu
7	discriminatory conduct or practice was motivated by antisemitic intent.
8	→SECTION 4. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 61 IS CREATED TO
9	READ AS FOLLOWS:
10	(1) As used in this section, "alien" has the same meaning as in 8 U.S.C. sec. 1101.
11	(2) Any alien who endorses or espouses terrorist activity in violation of the
12	Immigration and Nationality Act, including aliens on student or other temporary
13	visas, shall be subject to immediate arrest by a law enforcement officer and
14	transferred to the federal authorities for deportation proceedings.
15	→ Section 5. Antisemitism includes the examples set forth in House Resolution
16	41, adopted by the Kentucky House of Representatives on February 24, 2021.
17	→ Section 6. Whereas the General Assembly is committed to protecting Jewish
18	people, including Jewish students, from credible threats of violence or violence motivated
19	by antisemitism, an emergency is declared to exist, and this Act takes effect upon its
20	passage and approval by the Governor or upon its otherwise becoming a law.
