

1 AN ACT relating to the Kentucky Cybersecurity Center.

2 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:*

3 ➔SECTION 1. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 164 IS CREATED TO  
4 READ AS FOLLOWS:

5 *(1) The General Assembly hereby finds that there is a growing threat of cyberattacks*  
6 *across Kentucky. There is a need to address this threat by bringing together*  
7 *public and private partners for workforce development, research, innovation, and*  
8 *economic development. The National Security Agency, the United States*  
9 *Department of Homeland Security, and the United States Department of Defense*  
10 *have made significant investments in cybersecurity research, workforce training,*  
11 *and education at the University of Louisville.*

12 *(2) There is hereby created and established the Kentucky Cybersecurity Center within*  
13 *the University of Louisville. For purposes of this Act, the Kentucky Cybersecurity*  
14 *Center shall be known as "KentuckyCYBER." The University of Louisville shall*  
15 *have the authority to hire staff, contract for services, expend funds, and operate*  
16 *the normal business activities of KentuckyCYBER.*

17 *(3) It shall be the purpose of KentuckyCYBER to:*

18 *(a) Facilitate cooperation among universities, primary education facilities, and*  
19 *businesses to create a secure cyberinfrastructure;*

20 *(b) Educate state and local agencies and private sector participants about how*  
21 *to maintain secure cyberinfrastructure; and*

22 *(c) Accelerate the adoption of cybersecurity systems in the Commonwealth by*  
23 *combining the assets of higher education, state and federal agencies, and*  
24 *private companies.*

25 *(4) The duties of KentuckyCYBER shall include but not be limited to:*

26 *(a) Train and upskill a workforce to provide cybersecurity solutions for*  
27 *Kentucky businesses, state and local government, and federal, state, and*

- 1           local law enforcement;
- 2           (b) Provide cybersecurity resources, including but not limited to cyber ranges
- 3           and incident response teams, to assist state and local government, major
- 4           economic sectors including healthcare and manufacturing, and critical
- 5           infrastructure systems operators throughout Kentucky;
- 6           (c) Enhance economic development through cybersecurity initiatives that serve
- 7           major economic sectors of Kentucky;
- 8           (d) Create a cyber-innovation ecosystem for state and federal government, law
- 9           enforcement, the private sector, and K-12 and higher education institutions
- 10           to innovate rapidly and strengthen Kentucky's cybersecurity defenses with a
- 11           qualified workforce;
- 12           (e) Establish a cybersecurity research center and provide support to build the
- 13           research capacity necessary to successfully compete for projects funded by
- 14           the federal government and private industry participants; and
- 15           (f) Provide nonpartisan cybersecurity advice and recommendations to
- 16           Kentucky policymakers.
- 17           (5) Nothing in this section shall require any entity to cooperate with
- 18           KentuckyCYBER in carrying out the provisions of this section.
- 19           (6) There is hereby created a trust and revolving fund to be known as the
- 20           KentuckyCYBER fund. The fund shall consist of moneys appropriated by the
- 21           General Assembly, contributions, gifts, or grants made available for the purposes
- 22           set forth in this section, which shall be excluded from the comprehensive funding
- 23           model established in KRS 164.092.
- 24           (7) The fund shall be administered by the University of Louisville or its designated
- 25           department.
- 26           (8) Notwithstanding KRS 45.229, any moneys remaining in the fund at the close of
- 27           the fiscal year shall not lapse but shall be carried forward to the next fiscal year.

1 (9) Any interest earnings of the fund shall become a part of the fund and shall not  
2 lapse.

3 (10) Moneys deposited in the fund are hereby appropriated for the purposes set forth  
4 in this section and shall not be appropriated or transferred by the General  
5 Assembly for any other purpose.
