1 AN ACT relating to jails.

## 2 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:

- 3 → Section 1. KRS 431.215 is amended to read as follows:
- 4 (1) If the judgment imposes a sentence of death or confinement in the penitentiary,
- 5 county jail or other institution, two (2) certified copies thereof shall be furnished
- 6 forthwith to the sheriff who shall execute the same by delivering the defendant and
- a certified copy of the judgment to the person in charge of the penitentiary, jail or
- 8 institution of confinement and making a written return thereof in the office of the
- 9 circuit clerk within ten (10) days after the execution.
- 10 (2) When the judgment imposes a sentence of death or confinement in the penitentiary,
- the county in which the prisoner is incarcerated shall receive from the State
- Treasury a fee per day beginning on the day on which *the prisoner is first lodged in*
- the county jail, detention facility, or correctional facility[judgment was rendered]
- and ending the day that the *prisoner*[defendant] is delivered to the penitentiary. The
- 15 fee shall be paid to the county treasurer for use for the incarceration of prisoners as
- 16 provided in KRS 441.025.
- → SECTION 2. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 431 IS CREATED TO
- 18 READ AS FOLLOWS:
- 19 The State Treasury shall pay to the county the fee set forth in Section 1 of this Act, and
- 20 if applicable, the fees set forth in KRS 532.100(7) for each day a prisoner is charged
- 21 with a felony and lodged in the county jail, detention facility, or correctional facility.
- 22 The State Treasury shall cease payment on the day that the prisoner is acquitted of the
- 23 felony charges against him or her, or has judgment rendered otherwise involving no
- 24 felony.
