

1           A JOINT RESOLUTION designating the future United States Highway 460 twin  
2 bridges in Pike County, in honor and loving memory of Harrell Caudill.

3           WHEREAS, Harrell Caudill was born December 27, 1952, to his parents, the late  
4 Geneva Maggard and Alvin Caudill; and

5           WHEREAS, Harrell Caudill was a longtime engineer for the Department of  
6 Highways; and

7           WHEREAS, Harrell Caudill was a respected member of the Sutton Baptist Church  
8 in Shelbiana; and

9           WHEREAS, Harrell Caudill was preceded in death by his parents Alvin and  
10 Geneva, and son Kelly Taylor Caudill; and

11           WHEREAS, Harrell Caudill is survived by his wife, Jill Taylor Caudill; brother,  
12 Darrell Caudill, sisters: Rhonda Owens and Wanda Wilson; grandsons, Blake and Jake;  
13 and a host of family and friends;

14           NOW, THEREFORE,

15 ***Be it resolved by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:***

16           ➔Section 1. The Transportation Cabinet is hereby directed to designate the future  
17 United States Highway 460 twin bridges in Pike County as the "Harrell Caudill Memorial  
18 Bridge," and shall, within 30 days of the effective date of this Resolution, erect the  
19 appropriate signage.
