

1 A RESOLUTION declaring January 30, 2020, Live United Day in Kentucky.

2 WHEREAS, the 23 United Ways across Kentucky fight for the health, education,
3 and financial stability of every person in every Kentucky community; and

4 WHEREAS, United Way advances the common good by creating opportunities for
5 a good quality of life for all; and

6 WHEREAS, the building blocks for a good quality of life are education, income,
7 and health, upon which individual lives are improved and lasting community change is
8 realized; and

9 WHEREAS, United Way achieves these goals by successfully encouraging
10 communities to give, advocate, and volunteer; and

11 WHEREAS, United Way donors and volunteers are over 100,000 strong across the
12 Commonwealth, collectively reinvesting more than \$42 million and actively mobilizing

15 crucial for a child's success in school and life, and is dedicated to improving and
16 expanding early education and development programs for Kentucky's youngest children
17 through engagement, giving, advocating, and volunteering; and

19 Kentucky communities and is committed to helping all Kentuckians achieve family-
20 sustaining financial stability; and

21 WHEREAS, United Way recognizes that good health is fundamental to a child's
22 ability to provide for a family; and

23 WHEREAS, the Kentucky Senate hereby recognizes United Way's tireless efforts
24 and salutes its commitment to advancing education, financial stability, and health for
25 Kentucky's individuals, families, and communities.
