

1 A RESOLUTION recognizing and honoring the life-saving actions of Corporal Ben  
2 Webb.

3 WHEREAS, on January 23, 2024, London Police Department's Corporal Ben Webb  
4 was on a routine patrol when he was made aware of an 18-year-old man who had  
5 inadvertently cut his leg and potentially had cut an artery; and

6 WHEREAS, when Corporal Webb arrived on the scene, he found that bystanders  
7 had applied a tourniquet, but quickly observed it had not been properly secured, causing  
8 the blood to continue to flow; and

9 WHEREAS, Corporal Ben Webb pulled from his training and acted quickly to  
10 reapply the tourniquet and successfully stopped the bleeding until paramedics could  
11 arrive. The young man was flown to a nearby hospital and treated, and is expected to  
12 make a full recovery; and

13 WHEREAS, Corporal Ben Webb showed keen observational skills and quick  
14 thinking to assist in the potentially life-threatening injury of a young man; and

15 WHEREAS, Corporal Ben Webb is described by his captain at the London Police  
16 Department as "an exemplary officer [who] has always performed his duties with pride,  
17 professionalism, and integrity"; and

18 WHEREAS, Corporal Ben Webb believes being a police officer is part of a higher  
19 calling, saying, "I just have a servant's heart. I believe that God will bless you for wanting  
20 to help others, and that's all I've ever wanted to do. I was raised to respect the police and I  
21 believe that this is still one of the most noble professions"; and

22 WHEREAS, Corporal Ben Webb is a testament to the law enforcement profession  
23 and an asset to the London Police Department and the community they serve;

24 NOW, THEREFORE,

25 ***Be it resolved by the Senate of the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of***  
26 ***Kentucky:***

27 ➔Section 1. The Senate does hereby commend and honor the life-saving actions

1 of Corporal Ben Webb on January 23, 2024.

2       ➔Section 2. When the Senate adjourns this day, it does so in honor of Corporal  
3 Ben Webb.
