

1 A RESOLUTION honoring the Scott High School Girls' Cross Country Team upon
2 winning the 2019 Class 2A State Championship.

3 WHEREAS, the Scott High School Girls' Cross Country Team established itself in
4 2018 as a force to be reckoned with in the Commonwealth by winning the 2018 state
5 championship, and further cemented its dominance by capturing its second consecutive
6 Class 2A title in 2019; and

7 WHEREAS, Scott High School returned its top four runners from the 2018 meet,
8 and those new to varsity competition proved to be vital pieces of the state championship
9 puzzle; and

10 WHEREAS, the state meet, held on November 2, 2019, at the Kentucky Horse
11 Park, showcases the top running talent in the Commonwealth, and features more than
12 2,000 competitors; and

13 WHEREAS, Scott High bested second place Christian Academy of Louisville with
14 a total time of 1:41:34, and was paced by Maddie Strong, who finished third overall;
15 Juliana Ellington, who finished seventh overall; Dyllan Hasler, who finished twelfth
16 overall; Allison Clemons, who finished 26th overall; Laney Coleman, who finished 30th
17 overall; and Lorin Neal, who finished 35th overall; and

18 WHEREAS, Scott High School is ably coached by Zach Triplett, and it is
19 appropriate that this body commends his and his support staff's hard work in molding
20 these student-athletes into state champions; and

21 WHEREAS, the members also acknowledge the diligence of the athletes' families
22 for their support of these young competitors off the track, and duly commend the
23 community at Scott High School for all they have done to help prepare these athletes for
24 their historic accomplishment;
