3	WHEREAS, John Walczak has been an employee of the Louisville Zoo since 1985,
4	and has served as its director since 2004; and
5	WHEREAS, as director, Mr. Walczak has been responsible for shaping the Zoo's
6	vision as well as creating and implementing its strategic plan while overseeing the work
7	of 120 full-time, 10 part-time, and more than 100 seasonal employees; and
8	WHEREAS, under Mr. Walczak's leadership, the Louisville Zoo has added the
9	Islands, Gorilla Forest, and Glacier Run exhibits, which have been recognized by the
10	Association of Zoos and Aquariums (AZA) for excellence and innovation; and
11	WHEREAS, Mr. Walczak led the Louisville Zoo to achieve the AZA Significant
12	Achievement Education Award for its School at the Zoo program, and received Top
13	Honors in the AZA's 2017 International Conservation Award for gorilla conservation; and
14	WHEREAS, Mr. Walczak has been influential within the AZA as well, having
15	served on the Ethics Board, Membership Committee, Government Affairs Committee,
16	Honors and Awards Committee, Accreditation Commission, and the Board of Directors;

18	WHEREAS, under Mr. Walczak's leadership, the Louisville Zoo has achieved
19	milestone conservation efforts, including the birth of male elephant calf "Fitz" and the
20	addition of the rescued polar bear "Qannik"; and
21	WHEREAS, Mr. Walczak oversaw a \$14 million fundraising campaign, which
22	helped to expand and renovate the elephant exhibit, create the Little Penguin
23	Conservation Center, and add the Snow Leopard Pass and Colobus Crossing exhibits; and
24	WHEREAS, this \$14 million fundraising campaign is also currently funding
25	renovations to Lemur Mountain, which will be completed and reopened in 2021; and
26	WHEREAS, the Louisville Zoo has had over 25 million visitors during Mr.
27	Walczak's tenure as director; and
