

1 A RESOLUTION honoring Rachel Craig upon being named the 2020 Distinguished  
2 Young Woman of Christian County.

3 WHEREAS, the Distinguished Young Woman national scholarship program  
4 promotes and rewards scholastic excellence, leadership, and talent in high school senior  
5 girls; and

6 WHEREAS, Rachel Craig is a senior at University Heights Academy in  
7 Hopkinsville, Kentucky; and

8 WHEREAS, eight local girls competed in the scholarship program, with Rachel  
9 Craig winning the \$1,000 award and earning the opportunity to compete in the state  
10 Distinguished Young Women Scholarship Program in Lexington; and

11 WHEREAS, each participant was scored individually in five categories: talent,  
12 fitness, interview, scholastic, and self-expression. Rachel Craig performed a pointe  
13 routine, leaning on her dancing experience with the Bluegrass Dancecats, Campanile  
14 Productions, and her varsity cheerleading experience at University Heights Academy; and

15 WHEREAS, it is appropriate that this august body commend those young  
16 Kentuckians whose achievements serve to highlight their hard work and God-given  
17 talent, and whose accomplishments serve as an example for all this Commonwealth's  
18 youth; and

21 grant her best wishes as she continues on to the state competition in 2020;
