

1 A RESOLUTION honoring Chris Evensen upon the successful completion of his

3 WHEREAS, a native of Lexington, Kentucky, and a resident of Louisville,
4 Kentucky, Chris Evensen is a proud graduate of Wake Forest University, where he
5 graduated with honors in 1996; and

6 WHEREAS, Chris Evensen returned to Kentucky and graduated *cum laude* from
7 the University of Louisville Louis D. Brandeis School of Law in 1999; and

8 WHEREAS, in October 1999, Chris Evensen began practicing law, representing
9 injured people in workers' compensation claims and other personal injury suits; and

10 WHEREAS, in 2006, Chris Evensen became a partner in his firm and in 2008, he
11 started the Evensen Law Office; and

12 WHEREAS, Chris Evensen is the recipient of several awards and commendations
13 for his professional work, including National Lawyer of the Year and Kentucky's Best
14 Lawyer. He also received AV Preeminent distinction by his peers for attaining the highest
15 level of professional excellence; and

16 WHEREAS, in July 2020, Chris Evensen was elected President of the Kentucky
17 Workers Association; and

18 WHEREAS, the Kentucky Workers Association is a statewide professional
19 association comprised of skilled practitioners of workers' compensation law; and

20 WHEREAS, upon the successful completion of his term as President of the
21 Kentucky Workers Association, this body rightfully honors Chris Evensen, thanks him
22 for his years of service to this Commonwealths workers, and grants him Godspeed as he
23 embarks upon the next chapter of his professional career;
