5	Regiment, 101st Airborne Division; and
6	WHEREAS, Staff Sergeant Nicholas Davis is a seven-year combat veteran who
7	served a tour in Afghanistan and had most recently returned home from a mission
8	supporting Iraqi security forces in their fight to retake Mosul; and
9	WHEREAS, Staff Sergeant Nicholas Davis was traveling to Chattanooga,
10	Tennessee on June 9, 2017, when he discovered an overturned car on the side of the
11	highway; and
12	WHEREAS, Staff Sergeant Nicholas Davis stopped, immediately checked the well-
13	being of the citizens in the car, and found a small engine fire in the underbelly of the
14	vehicle with two people pinned inside; and
15	WHEREAS, Staff Sergeant Nicholas Davis used the glass breaker on his pocket
16	knife to shatter the window, allowing him access to the two people within; and
17	WHEREAS, with leaking fuel and blazing flames around him, Staff Sergeant
18	Nicholas Davis quickly pushed the man out of the vehicle and pulled the woman through
19	the tight door opening; and
20	WHEREAS, Staff Sergeant Nicholas Davis heroically rescued both citizens from
21	the burning car but suffered second degree burns on over 75 percent of his leg as a result
22	of his bravery; and
23	WHEREAS, the Soldier's Medal, established more than 90 years ago by the United
24	States Congress, is the highest honor a soldier can receive for an act of valor in a non-
25	combat situation; and
26	WHEREAS, Staff Sergeant Nicholas Davis, for his selfless actions on June 9, 2017,
