

1           A RESOLUTION adjourning the Senate in honor and loving memory of Bernard  
2 Jerome Osborne.

3           WHEREAS, Bernard Jerome Osborne, a native of Hardin County and respected  
4 resident of Elizabethtown, Kentucky, was the cherished son of the late William Leslie  
5 "W.L." Osborne Sr. and Louise Generose Peak Osborne; and

6           WHEREAS, Bernard Jerome Osborne served his country throughout World War II,  
7 stationed first at Godman Army Airfield in Fort Knox, Kentucky, and later deployed to  
8 England, France, and Germany. He became a cryptographer of an Army Air Corps  
9 reconnaissance wing; and

10           WHEREAS, Bernard Jerome Osborne retired from Osborne Quarry in  
11 Elizabethtown, Kentucky, and was a charter member of the Kentucky Crushed Stone  
12 Association; and

13           WHEREAS, Bernard Jerome Osborne was a dedicated member of St. John Catholic  
14 Church, a member of Knights of Columbus in Vine Grove, a member of American  
15 Legion Post No. 113, and an active Kentucky Colonel; and

16           WHEREAS, on January 27, 2018, Bernard Jerome Osborne departed this earthly  
17 life, leaving those whose lives he touched in solemn mourning; and

18           WHEREAS, in addition to his parents, Bernard Jerome Osborne was preceded in  
19 death by his wife of 65 years, Wyla Mae Hobbs Osborne; and his siblings, Jimmy  
20 Osborne, Paul Osborne, Mac Osborne, Sis Stith, Bill Osborne, Pete Osborne, Aggie  
21 Dunn, Anne Spears, Alice Mulhall, and Margaret Susan Crady. He is survived by his  
22 beloved daughters, Pamela Kentfield and her husband, Tom, and Kathy Smith and her  
23 husband, Carlos; his grandchildren, Jeremy Smith and his wife, Julie, Lauren Simms and  
24 her husband, Ryan, and Andrea Ball and her husband, Derek; his great-grandchildren,  
25 Logan Ball, Mason Ball, Brennan Ball, Addison Smith, Parker Smith, Keaton Simms, and  
26 Carson Simms; and many other family, friends, and loved ones;
