11	Commonwealth, and passionate organizations in Kentucky involved with the life-saving
12	mission of organ, eye, and tissue donation have come together to celebrate the gift of life;

14	WHEREAS, this body thanks those agencies, including the Kentucky Circuit Court
15	Clerks' Trust for Life, whose efforts toward this cause have been essential; and
16	WHEREAS, the goal of these advocates is to educate Kentuckians on the miracle of
17	donation and transplantation, with the hope that all those applying for drivers' licenses at
18	the Circuit Clerk's office also register as donors at that time; and
19	WHEREAS, in so doing, this body urges Kentuckians to remember those heroic
20	donors and their families whose generosity saved lives, celebrate those who have received
21	their gift of life, recognize those still waiting for their gift, and honor those who lost the
22	fight and died waiting;
