3	WHEREAS, the 19th Amendment to the United States Constitution was ratified in
4	1920, which allowed for the single largest expansion of our electorate in the last 100
5	years; and
6	WHEREAS, the League of Women Voters was founded in 1920 by the women
7	leaders of the suffrage movement, their goal being to help the 20 million women
8	understand and carry out their new responsibility as voters; and
9	WHEREAS, with the success of this effort and the tireless efforts over the last 100
10	years to strengthen and upholds its mission to empower voters and defend democracy, the
11	League of Women Voters has become a trusted, grassroots organization; and
12	WHEREAS, the League of Women Voters has sponsored legislation to protect and
13	strengthen voting rights and access, and for free and fair elections, civil rights, children,
14	community health, the environment, and education; and
15	WHEREAS, the League of Women Voters has consistently been noted for its
16	nonpartisan election information, including sponsorship of candidate forums and
17	information on state and local ballot issues, as well as its commitment to register,
18	educate, and mobilize voters; and
19	WHEREAS, the League of Women Voters believes that active and engaged citizens
20	regardless of gender, ethnicity, or political affiliation are the hallmark of democracy; and
21	WHEREAS, the Senate declares February 13, 2020, as a Day of Celebration of the
22	100th anniversary of the League of Women Voters and a Day of Action as "Women
23	Power the Vote";
