3	WHEREAS, 37 million Americans suffer from kidney disease; and
4	WHEREAS, most adults suffering from kidney disease are not aware they have it;

6	WHEREAS, risks associated with chronic kidney disease include heart disease and
7	stroke, anemia, and end-stage kidney disease; and
8	WHEREAS, in Kentucky, 1,024 people died of kidney disease in 2017, which is the
9	fifth highest rate in the United States; and
10	WHEREAS, more than 100,000 Americans are awaiting a kidney transplant; and
11	WHEREAS, more than 468,000 Americans are on kidney dialysis; and
12	WHEREAS, the only effective way to treat kidney disease is to detect it early; and
13	WHEREAS, in this spirit, this honorable body supports the advocacy of those
14	working to bring awareness about kidney disease on this day; and
15	WHEREAS, in so doing, the members declare March 12, 2020, as Kidney Disease
16	Awareness Day in Kentucky; thank all those associated with the diagnosis, treatment, and
17	advocacy of kidney disease in this Commonwealth, including the American Association
18	of Kidney Patients and the National Kidney Foundation; and acknowledge the daily
19	struggle of those Kentuckians who are currently suffering from kidney disease;
20	NOW, THEREFORE,
21	Be it resolved by the Senate of the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of
22	Kentucky:
23	→Section 1. The Senate hereby declares March 12, 2020, Kidney Disease
24	Awareness Day in Kentucky.
25	\Rightarrow Section 2. When the Senate adjourns this day, it does so in honor of those
26	individuals suffering from kidney disease in this Commonwealth.
