

1 A RESOLUTION adjourning the Senate in honor and loving memory of Gail Lee
2 Chambers Brown.

3 WHEREAS, Gail Lee Chambers Brown was born on July 24, 1966, in Huntingdon,
4 Pennsylvania, the cherished daughter of Frances Wiley Chambers Anness and Charles
5 Chambers; and

6 WHEREAS, Gail Brown was a proud 1984 graduate of Mercer County High School
7 and a 1995 graduate of the Lexington Academy of Beauty. A hairstylist at Tim Murphy's
8 Salon, she was also the owner of Rumors and Razors Salon; and

9 WHEREAS, Gail Brown was a pillar of the Harrodsburg community. The first
10 female president of the Harrodsburg Kiwanis Club, she was a Kentucky Colonel and had
11 received the Kiwanian of the Year Award, the Pioneer Award from the Mercer County
12 Chamber of Commerce, and the Louise Dean Award from the James Harrod Trust, as
13 well as other commendations for her leadership and service; and

14 WHEREAS, Gail Lee Chambers Brown departed this earthly life and entered into
15 the kingdom of Heaven on August 27, 2017, leaving her family, friends, and all those
16 whose lives she touched in solemn mourning; and

17 WHEREAS, Gail Brown is survived by her husband, Keith; sons, Richard and his
18 wife, Jessica, Kalin, and Aidan; mother, Frances Anness and her husband, Henry; sister,
19 Connie Chambers Edwards and her husband, Douglas; grandson, Greyson; and a host of
20 other family members, friends, and loved ones who will dearly miss her presence in their
21 lives;
