Green; and 5 WHEREAS, Terry Green enjoyed an illustrious 20-year career as a naval pilot, 6 flying helicopters and fixed-wing aircrafts in Alaska, California, Kentucky, New York, 7 and Antarctica. He was awarded the Navy Commendation Medal, Navy Achievement Medal, Meritorious Unit Commendation, Antarctica Service Medal, National Defense 8 9 Medal, Sea Service Ribbon, Recruiting Service Ribbon, Overseas Service Ribbon, Rifle 10 and Expert Pistol Medal, a Congressional Commendation, two Search and Rescue 11 Awards, and 15 Gold Wreath Awards. In 2016, Mr. Green was awarded the New Zealand 12 Special Service Medal for his heroic onsite assistance in that government's Operation 13 Overdue, following the crash of an Air New Zealand flight on Mount Erebus in 14 Antarctica; and WHEREAS, after his retirement, Terry Green worked with Larry Burkett's Christian 15 16 Financial Concepts Ministry and, upon return to Harrodsburg, he owned the McGee 17 House, which is on the National Register of Historic Homes. He was an active member of 18 the Harrodsburg Rotary Club, a co-founder and board member of Central Kentucky 19 Christian School, and owner of Green Integrity Services. Mr. Green served as a Mercer 20 County Constable and was very active in local policy making. He acted in several plays in 21 the Ragged Edge Community Theater and Old Fort Harrod outdoor theater and drama 22 production, bringing joy to all those who attended; and 23 WHEREAS, Terry Green was a faithful member and elder of the New Providence 24 Presbyterian Church for 18 years, teaching Sunday school and leading the Harrodsburg 25 Men's Interdenominational Bible Study Group; and 26 WHEREAS, Terry Green departed this earthly life and entered into the kingdom of

Heaven on July 7, 2017. He is survived by his wife, Marybeth G. Green; four daughters,
