1	A RESOLUTION honoring Sergeant Robert I. "Gus" Koch for his exemplary
2	service to the United States and to the Commonwealth of Kentucky.
3	WHEREAS, Gus Koch volunteered for the Marine Corps in January of 1966 and
4	immediately went to boot camp at Marine Corps Recruit Depot San Diego; and
5	WHEREAS, upon graduation from boot camp he was sent to Camp Pendleton in
6	California for guerilla warfare training and then to the Republic of Vietnam in July of
7	1966; and
8	WHEREAS, Sergeant Koch was stationed in Da Nang and was attached to the 5th
9	Communication Battalion as a teletype operator, but spent the majority of his time as a
10	driver and courier between Communication Center on the South China Sea and Monkey
11	and Marble Mountains; and
12	WHEREAS, Sergeant Koch served 12 months in the Republic of Vietnam;
13	spending the remainder of his service at Camp Lejeune training Marines for deployment
14	in Vietnam; and
15	WHEREAS, Sergeant Koch achieved the rank of Sergeant in 18 months, which was
16	and still is an incredible feat and evidence of his professionalism and dedication to his
17	country; and
18	WHEREAS, after receiving an honorable discharge upon completion of his military
19	service, Gus Koch returned to the civilian world where he entered the horse business and
20	married his wife Theresa. They have 10 children and 32 grandchildren, including
21	Matthew R. Koch, who followed his father into the United States Marine Corps, served as
22	an intelligence officer in Kosovo, and eventually earned the rank of Captain, finishing his
23	career as the assistant intel Officer for the 6th Marine Air Ground Task Force in
24	Afghanistan;
