7	the top teams in the tournament field to play in the championship game; and
8	WHEREAS, falling in the waning moments, the Thorobrettes lost 44-42 to Lane
9	College in a nail-biter of a championship game; and
10	WHEREAS, it was the second time in four seasons that the Thorobrettes advanced
11	to the title contest under the leadership of Head Coach Terrance Slater; and
12	WHEREAS, Kentucky State was limited to seven players and held the conference's
13	best player to just five points; and
14	WHEREAS, the team entered the SIAC Tournament as the lowest seed and seventh
15	in the West Division; and
16	WHEREAS, the Thorobrettes posted three upsets, beating the first, second, and
17	third seeds in the tournament over a four-day span; and
18	WHEREAS, senior Brooke Wallace and sophomore Erica Jones were named to the
19	SIAC All-Tournament Team; and
20	WHEREAS, Wallace led the team with 14 points and 14 rebounds in the
21	championship game. She averaged 11.8 points and 11.3 rebounds in tournament play; and
22	WHEREAS, in addition to their athletic exploits, the Kentucky State University
23	women's basketball team recorded a 3.496 Grade Point Average last semester, the highest
24	in the athletics department. In the fall term, 11 of the 12 rostered student-athletes posted
25	at least a 3.0 GPA; and
26	WHEREAS, three of the student-athletes-Brooke Wallace, Jessie Kee, and Amani
27	Williams—finished the term with perfect 4.0 GPA's; and
