4 and Rachel Pinkston Harley; and

5 WHEREAS, Lonnie Harley was a farmer in Harrodsburg where he and his wife,
6 Ann Thompson, lived for most of their lives and were an integral part of the Harrodsburg
7 community. Mr. Harley was a lifetime supporter of the Republican Party; and

9 had recently been attending Carpenter's Christian Church; and
