2 David.

3 WHEREAS, Clifton David was a son of this Commonwealth, having been born in
4 Louisville on August 24, 1941, to the late Jeff and Henrietta David; and

5 WHEREAS, Clifton David was a proud graduate of Louisville Male High School in
6 the Class of 1958. He went on to attend the University of Colorado at Boulder and earned
7 his associate's degree at the University of Louisville; and

8 WHEREAS, Clifton David worked for many years as a substitute teacher in the
9 Jefferson County Public School System and as an academic advisor at the University of
10 Louisville. A member of the American Center for Law and Justice, he was a noted
11 scholar on civil rights issues who had versed himself in the history of that struggle; and

12 WHEREAS, an avid high school basketball and University of Louisville sports fan,
13 Clifton David enjoyed performing karaoke; and

14 WHEREAS, Clifton David, beloved husband, father, grandfather, and brother,
15 departed this earthly life and entered into the kingdom of Heaven on February 4, 2020,
16 leaving his family, friends, and all those whose lives he touched in solemn mourning; and

17 WHEREAS, Clifton David was preceded in death by his wife, Mary A. David;
18 grandson, Michael L. David Sr.; and siblings, Bernard David, Kathleen D. Williams, and
19 Bennie M. David. He is survived by his daughters, Marcia Moore and Deondra (Kevin)
20 Kimble; grandchildren, Jennifer Kimble, Chantel Moore, Andrew Henderson, and Terry
21 L. Crumpton II; eight great-grandchildren; and siblings, Vernon E. David, Charles E.
