

1 A RESOLUTION honoring Pat Mattingly upon the occasion of his retirement from
2 Pat's Pharmacy.

3 WHEREAS, Pat Mattingly graduated from the University of Kentucky Pharmacy
4 School in December of 1973; and

5 WHEREAS, Mr. Mattingly opened his own pharmacy, Pat's Pharmacy, in October
6 of 1984 in Lebanon, Kentucky; and

7 WHEREAS, Pat's Pharmacy has operated under Mr. Mattingly's leadership for
8 thirty-six years; and

9 WHEREAS, January 26, 2021, was Mr. Mattingly's final day as pharmacist for Pat's
10 Pharmacy; and

11 WHEREAS, Mr. Mattingly has successfully navigated great changes in the
12 pharmaceutical industry over his tenure, including the introduction of computers and
13 insurance drug cards; and

14 WHEREAS, Mr. Mattingly cared greatly about maintaining an independent
15 pharmacy and providing personalized care; and

16 WHEREAS, Mr. Mattingly has served as a mentor to younger pharmacists and
17 other employees over his career; and

18 WHEREAS, during an admissions interview for pharmacy school, Mr. Mattingly
19 was asked why he wanted to become a pharmacist and responded with a simple "To help
20 people"; and

21 WHEREAS, Mr. Mattingly's business partner, Joe Kelly Johnson, has stated that
22 Mr. Mattingly "truly cared about people, and it showed in his actions. He very much
23 cared about the people and the outcome"; and

24 WHEREAS, Mr. Mattingly was known to help those in his community outside of
25 his pharmacy as well, such as by running errands for community members who lacked
26 families; and

27 WHEREAS, Mr. Johnson will continue to operate Pat's Pharmacy now that Mr.

1 Mattingly has retired; and

2 WHEREAS, Mr. Mattingly looks forward to reading, playing golf, travelling, and
3 spending more time with his wife, Mayhala; daughter, Ann; son, Patrick; and six
4 grandchildren;

6 *Be it resolved by the Senate of the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of*
7 *Kentucky:*

8 ➔Section 1. The members of the Senate rightfully commend Pat Mattingly for his
9 four decades of service to his community as pharmacist.
