

1 A RESOLUTION honoring the Campbellsville University women's basketball team  
2 upon reaching the NAIA Division I Final Four.

3 WHEREAS, after being defeated by the University of the Cumberlands on March 2,  
4 2017, the Campbellsville University women's basketball team earned a berth in the NAIA  
5 Division I National Championship in Billings, Montana; and

6 WHEREAS, after dispatching Talladega College and number eight-ranked Baker  
7 University, Campbellsville took on undefeated and top-ranked Freed-Hardeman  
8 University on March 18, 2017; and

9 WHEREAS, paced by Emily Fox's 20 points, Lexxus Graham's 16, and Madison  
10 Stewart's 14, Campbellsville stunned Freed-Hardeman 73-70 and advanced to the  
11 semifinals to take on Oklahoma City; and

12 WHEREAS, even though Campbellsville fell to Oklahoma City, the season was one  
13 of the finest in program history, as it saw the Lady Tigers win 28 games against only 7  
14 losses and compete for a national championship; and

15 WHEREAS, it is appropriate that this honorable body commend those athletic  
16 teams who band together to achieve greatness; and

17 WHEREAS, in this spirit, the members congratulate the Campbellsville University  
18 women's basketball team upon its successful 2016-2017 season, acknowledge the hard  
19 work of Coach Ginger Colvin and her staff for what they have accomplished for these  
20 student-athletes on and off the court, and commend the entire Campbellsville community  
21 for its ardent and passionate support of this extraordinary team;
