

1 A RESOLUTION adjourning the Senate in honor and loving memory of Jill Brock.

2 WHEREAS, Jill Mary Brock (nee Schilling), 65, of Petersburg, Kentucky, passed
3 away Saturday, March 12, 2022, in Port Charlotte, Florida. She was born May 1, 1956, in
4 Lafayette, Indiana, to the late Cletus William and Mary Gladys Schilling; and

5 WHEREAS, Jill was a member of the Benton Central High School Class of 1974.
6 Following high school, Jill attended and graduated from Purdue University in 1978 with a
7 major in Education. She completed her Master's in Education and achieved her Rank One
8 certification through Northern Kentucky University; and

9 WHEREAS, Jill had a passion for teaching and loved children; running a classroom
10 brought her true joy. She taught three years in Greensburg, Indiana, before moving to
11 Northern Kentucky where she taught the next 27 years at Taylor Mill Elementary. She
12 retired from Taylor Mill Elementary in June of 2011 and became a member of the Retired
13 Teachers of Kentucky. After her retirement, Jill enjoyed traveling and seeking out unique
14 restaurants and experiences with friends and family; and

15 WHEREAS, Jill was preceded in death by her parents, Cletus and Mary Schilling;
16 and her sister, Jeane Rattay. Jill is survived by her loving husband, Richard Brock; her
