8	to Advanced Placement (AP) coursework while maintaining or increasing the percentage

11	program through Advance Kentucky and through strong state policies that grow and
12	expand the program; and
13	WHEREAS, these supports are reflected in student gains ranking the
14	Commonwealth 10th in the nation in growth over the past 10 years in the percentage of
15	its graduating high school classes achieving successful AP exam scores; and
16	WHEREAS, Advanced Placement is a powerful resource in helping the
17	Commonwealth meets its goal of ensuring that all students graduate from high school
18	ready for college and careers, and prepared for a more complex and competitive
19	workplace;
20	NOW, THEREFORE,
21	Be it resolved by the Senate of the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of
22	Kentucky:
23	→ Section 1. The members of the Senate commend and acknowledge Boyd County
24	Schools, Campbellsville Independent Schools, Daviess County Schools, Dawson Springs
25	Independent Schools, Fort Thomas Independent Schools, Livingston County Schools,
26	Muhlenberg County Schools, and Pulaski County Schools for their leadership and pursuit
27	of academic excellence, and encourage continued success of these eight exemplary
