

1 A RESOLUTION honoring the Blueprint for Kentucky's Children and adjourning in
2 honor of Children's Advocacy Day, January 18, 2018.

3 WHEREAS, every child in Kentucky deserves the chance to live in a thriving
4 community and a strong family, and have the opportunity to be a successful kid; and

5 WHEREAS, the Blueprint for Kentucky's Children is a coalition of nonprofit,
6 private, and public organizations committed to making Kentucky a great place to be a kid;
7 and

8 WHEREAS, the Blueprint for Kentucky's Children calls for policies that promote
9 thriving communities, strong families, and successful kids in order to create a prosperous
10 future for Kentucky; and

11 WHEREAS, Children's Advocacy Day was established 14 years ago in 2004 as an
12 effort to raise the profile of children's issues among Kentucky's elected leaders; and

13 WHEREAS, Children's Advocacy Day recognizes steps taken by the General
14 Assembly to promote thriving communities, strong families, and successful kids; and

15 WHEREAS, giving a voice to young people through Children's Advocacy Day
16 serves as a powerful vehicle, reminding us all that Kentucky's children are the key to a
17 sustained and prosperous future for the Commonwealth;

19 ***Be it resolved by the Senate of the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of***
20 ***Kentucky:***

21 ➔Section 1. When the Senate adjourns this day, it does so in honor of Children's
22 Advocacy Day, January 18, 2018.

23 ➔Section 2. The Senate acknowledges the Blueprint for Kentucky's Children for
24 its role in improving the outcomes for the children of the Commonwealth.
