

1           A RESOLUTION recognizing February 8, 2022, as Career and Technical Education  
2 Student Leadership Day and February 2022 as Career and Technical Education Month in  
3 Kentucky.

4           WHEREAS, the Kentucky Association for Career and Technical Education  
5 commemorates Career and Technical Education Month with CTE Student Leadership  
6 Day on February 8, 2022; and

7           WHEREAS, the Association for Career and Technical Education established the  
8 theme "Celebrate Today, Own Tomorrow!" for Career and Technical Education Month,  
9 February 2022; and

10           WHEREAS, approximately 400 representatives of Kentucky's Career and Technical  
11 Education programs and their advisers are participating in CTE Student Leadership Day,  
12 which consists of a formal citizenship educational program and the opportunity to tour  
13 the Capitol and meet with their Representatives and Senators; and

14           WHEREAS, Career and Technical Education Student Organizations provide  
15 secondary and postsecondary students the opportunity to develop leadership skills and  
16 further explore possible career options, both of which enhance their ability to achieve  
17 success in life and become future leaders in the Commonwealth of Kentucky; and

18           WHEREAS, Kentucky Technology Student Association President Hewett  
19 Lessenberry, from Barren County, and Kentucky FFA State Sentinel Tristann Burks, from  
20 Barren County, represent all Career and Technical Student Organization members and  
21 CTE students before this body today;
