4 11, 1926, the cherished daughter of the late Dr. John and Loretta Kaye; and

7 the Lafayette School Corporation. A member of St. Mary Cathedral, where she served on
8 the Ladies Altar Rosary Society and the Christ Renews His Parish Team, she was on the
9 board of Duncan Hall and a member of the Catholic Women's Study Club; and

10 WHEREAS, a proud supporter of Lafayette Catholic Schools, Kathleen Gloyeske
11 served on the Lafayette Catholic Schools Foundation Board; and

13 departed this earthly life and entered into the kingdom of Heaven on November 29, 2017,
14 leaving her family, friends, and all those whose lives she touched in solemn mourning;

16 WHEREAS, the wife of Robert Gloyeske, Kathleen Gloyeske was the mother of
17 seven children: Ken and his wife; Barb; Beth Fleenor and her husband, Legislative
18 Research Commission employee Dave Fleenor; Steve and his wife, Linda; Maggie; Kate
19 Halsmer and her husband, Dominic; John and his wife, Julie; and Rob and his wife,
20 Vandana. She is survived by seventeen grandchildren; four great-grandchildren; and a
21 host of other family members, friends, and loved ones who will deeply miss her presence
22 in their lives;
