Amendments proposed by Representative Jackson to Engrossed House Bill No. 17 by Representative Emerson

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 2, delete "R.S. 18:2(12), 401(B)," and insert "R.S. 18:401(B),"

3 AMENDMENT NO. 2

4 On page 1, line 6, after "through" delete the remainder of the line and delete line 7, and
5 insert "410.11, relative"

6 AMENDMENT NO. 3

7 On page 2, delete lines 3 and 4, and insert "410.11, are hereby enacted to read as follows:"

8 AMENDMENT NO. 4

9 On page 6, delete lines 15 through 28, and on page 7, delete lines 1 through 10 and insert the
10 following:

11 "§410.11. Majority vote required
 12 A candidate who receives a majority of the votes cast for party primary office
 13 in a general election is elected. If no candidate receives a majority of votes, the two
 14 candidates receiving the highest number of votes are qualified as candidates in a
 15 subsequent election on the third Saturday after the date on which the results in the
 16 general election were promulgated."

17 AMENDMENT NO. 5

18 On page 13, delete lines 4 through 21 and insert the following:

19 "Section 2. This Act shall become effective January 1, 2025."
