13 On page 2, after line 12, add the following:

14 "§307. Private events at brewer facilities15 A. A brewer may lease its facility to a third party for not more than
16 twelve private events per year during which wine and sparkling wine may be
17 served to guests of the private event if all of the following conditions are
18 met:19 (1) A copy of the lease shall be provided to the commissioner at least
20 ten days prior to the event.21 (2) The brewer may charge a reasonable rental fee to the third party
22 for the private event.23 (3) The third party or brewer shall not charge a cover charge, entry
24 fee, or sell entry tickets in connection with the event.25 (4) No food or beverages shall be sold to guests of the private event.26 (5) The third party may serve to guests alcoholic beverages
27 manufactured by the brewer. The brewer shall not charge the third party
28 more than its standard prices for such products.29 (6) The third party may serve food to guests. Such food shall either
30 be prepared by the third party or by a restaurant or caterer hired by the third
31 party to prepare and serve the food."
