18	"(3)(a) For the purposes of this Paragraph, a digitized driver's license shall
19	mean a data file available on any mobile device which has connectivity to the
20	internet through an application which allows the mobile device to download the data
21	file from the department or an authorized representative of the department, which
22	contains all of the data elements visible on the face and back of the license, and also
23	displays the current status of the license. For the purposes of this Subparagraph,
24	"current status" shall include but is not limited to valid, expired, cancelled,
25	suspended, disqualified, hardship, or interlock hardship status.
26	(b) A digital copy, photograph, or image of a driver's license which is not
27	downloaded through the application on a mobile device shall not be a valid digitized
28	driver's license as provided by this Section.
29	(c) If a person is unable to produce a physical driver's license issued by the
30	department, in connection with a traffic stop or checkpoint, the person may present
31	a digitized driver's license to a law enforcement officer and shall not be issued any
32	citation for driving a motor vehicle without a valid license in his possession. Except
33	as provided in this Paragraph, a law enforcement officer or a representative of the
34	department is authorized to require the person to produce the physical driver's
35	license issued by the department, even if the person has a digitized driver's license
36	on his mobile device, and the failure to produce such physical driver's license when
37	so requested shall subject the person to all the applicable laws and consequences for

(d) The department shall promulgate such rules as are necessary to implement a digitized driver's license. No digitized driver's license shall be valid until the department has adopted such rules.

(e) The display of a digitized driver's license shall not serve as consent or authorization for a law enforcement officer, or any other person, to search, view, or access any other data or application on the mobile device. If a person presents their mobile device to a law enforcement officer for purposes of displaying their digitized driver's license, the law enforcement officer shall promptly return the mobile device to the person once he has had an opportunity to verify the identity and license status of the person.
