14 transmitted by telefax, electronic delivery, or by United States mail.15 (3) The written request shall contain all of the following:16 (a) The organization's name and citation to the United States Department of  
17 Health and Human Services website or correspondence evidencing its designation  
18 as an organ procurement organization for the state.19 (b) The donor's name.20 (c) The donor's date of birth.21 (d) The donor's date of death.22 (e) The requestor's name.23 (f) The requestor's telephone number.24 (g) The requestor's date of request.25 (h) A request that the certified copy be transmitted by telefax, electronic  
26 delivery, or by United States mail.27 (4) The information required by Paragraph (2) of this Subsection, together  
28 with the documentation of a donor's anatomical gift, shall constitute sufficient proof  
29 for the release of the death certificate.30 (5) If the organization's requested form of transmittal is by telefax or  
31 electronic delivery, the death certificate shall be accompanied by the state registrar's  
32 verification that the death certificate is a duplicate of the original, the date the copy  
33 of the death certificate was issued by the state registrar's representative, along with  
34 his signature and title."
