32 available for purchase by certified motor vehicle inspection stations during normal  
33 business hours. The stickers shall be in convenient book form and shall be sold in  
34 such practical increments as will not present a financial hardship to low volume  
35 stations. Motor vehicle inspection stickers shall not be distributed to each district  
36 office throughout the state or made available for purchase when a system of  
37 electronic filing or inspection information and print on-demand motor vehicle  
38 inspection certificates is implemented.

1 Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not  
2 signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without  
3 signature by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution  
4 of Louisiana. If vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the  
5 legislature, this Act shall become effective on the day following such approval."
