

HOUSE SUMMARY OF SENATE AMENDMENTS

House Bill No. 678 by Representative Fannin

APPROPRIATIONS/SUPPLEML: Provides for supplemental appropriations for Fiscal Year 2012-2013

Synopsis of Senate Amendments

1. Provides for a (\$37,629,609) reduction in State General Fund (Direct) in accordance with the governor's expenditure freeze, Executive Order BJ 2012-15.
2. Provides for an increase in State General Fund (Direct) of \$145,976,661.
3. Provides for other net increases (decreases) as follows: Interagency Transfers by \$4,122,654; Self-Generated Revenues by \$40,529,100; Statutory Dedications by \$392,711,246 and Federal Funds by \$2,014,727.

Digest of Bill as Finally Passed by Senate

Appropriates supplemental funding and provides for other budgetary adjustments for the 2012-2013 Fiscal Year.

Provides for a (\$37,629,609) reduction in State General Fund (Direct) in accordance with the governor's expenditure freeze, Executive Order BJ 2012-15. Provides for an increase in State General Fund (Direct) of \$146,016,838.

Provides for other net increases (decreases) as follows: Interagency Transfers by \$4,122,654; Self-Generated Revenues by \$40,529,100; Statutory Dedications by \$411,461,246 and Federal Funds by \$2,014,727.

Effective upon signature of governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
