AMENDMENT NO. 10

 - "Section 3.(A) Section 1 of this Act shall become effective when an Act of the legislature containing a specific appropriation of monies for the implementation of the provisions of Act becomes effective.
 - (B) Section 2 of this Act shall become effective one year from the date of effectiveness of Paragraph (A) of this Section.

 (C) The provisions of this Section shall become effective upon signature of this Act
 by the governor or, if not signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to
 become law without signature by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the
 Constitution of Louisiana. If this Act is vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved
 by the legislature, the provisions of this Section shall become effective on the day following
 such approval."
