Amendments proposed by Senate Committee on Judiciary C to Original Senate Bill No. 35 by Senator Colomb

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

- On page 2, delete lines 22 through 29, and on page 3, delete lines 1 through 3, and insert the following:
- 4 "(3) Any licensee or its subordinate contractor licensed by the 5 Department of Agriculture and Forestry to produce marijuana pursuant to R.S. 6 40:1046, and any employee, board member, director, or agent of a marijuana 7 licensee or its subordinate contractor licensed pursuant to R.S. 40:1046, shall 8 not be subject to arrest or prosecution for possession, manufacture, 9 preparation, distribution, purchase, preparation, or transportation of 10 marijuana, marijuana preparations, and marijuana paraphernalia under this Section. This defense shall be a complete bar to arrest and prosecution. This 11 Paragraph shall not prevent the imposition of penalties for diversion of 12 13 marijuana or other conduct outside the scope of the state-sponsored medical marijuana program or for violations of Department of Agriculture and Forestry 14 15 rules and regulations."

16 AMENDMENT NO. 2

17 On page 3, between lines 13 and 14, insert the following:

18 "Any person conducting research as the licensee pursuant to R.S. 19 40:1046 and any employee, board member, director, agent, or any person 20 conducting research in partnership with the licensee shall not be subject to 21 arrest or prosecution for possession, manufacture, preparation, distribution, 22 purchase, preparation, or transportation of marijuana, marijuana preparations, 23 and marijuana paraphernalia under this Section. This defense shall be a 24 complete bar to arrest and prosecution. This Paragraph shall not prevent the imposition of penalties for diversion of marijuana or other conduct outside the 25 scope of the state-sponsored medical marijuana program or for violations of 26 27 Department of Agriculture and Forestry rules and regulations."
