Amendments proposed by House Committee on Administration of Criminal Justice to Reengrossed Senate Bill No. 495 by Senator Martiny

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, delete line 2 in its entirety and insert "To amend and reenact R.S.
3 15:574.2(C)(4)(a)(introductory paragraph), 574.4(H), and 574.9(D)(1),"

4 AMENDMENT NO. 2

5 On page 1, line 4, after "requirements;" and before "to provide for" insert the following:

6 "to provide relative to administrative parole; to provide for the application
7 of administrative parole to offenders who commit an offense on or after a
8 certain date;"

9 AMENDMENT NO. 3

10 On page 1, line 7, after "Section 1." delete the remainder of the line and insert "R.S.
11 15:574.2(C)(4)(a)(introductory paragraph), 574.4(H), and 574.9(D)(1) are"

12 AMENDMENT NO. 4

13 On page 1, between lines 8 and 9, insert the following:

14 "§574.2. Committee on parole, Board of Pardons; membership;
15 qualifications; vacancies; compensation; domicile; venue; meetings;
16 quorum; panels; powers and duties; transfer of property to
17 committee; representation of applicants before the committee;
18 prohibitions

22 (4)(a) Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, each
23 offender who commits an offense on or after November 1, ~~2017~~, 2020, other
24 than a crime of violence as defined in R.S. 14:2(B) or a sex offense as
25 defined in R.S. 15:541, and eligible for parole pursuant to R.S.
26 15:574.4(A)(1), except those sentenced under R.S. 15:529.1 or R.S. 13:5401,
27 shall be released on administrative parole on the offender's parole eligibility
28 date without a hearing before the committee if all of the following conditions
29 are met:
