SUMMARY OF HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO THE SENATE BILL

1. Authorizes a school employee present to supervise a gathering to quietly bow his head during a student-led, student-initiated prayer in deference and respect.

<u>Present law</u> (R.S. 17:2115.3) provides that no law, rule, or policy may deny any student attending a public elementary or secondary school the right to participate in voluntary, student-initiated, student-led prayer.

<u>Present law</u> (R.S. 17:2115.11) provides conditions for student-initiated prayer and allows school employees to volunteer to supervise student-initiated prayer. Also provides that any school employee may participate in the gathering if it occurs before the employee's work day begins or after the employee's work day ends.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that if a school employee present to supervise the gathering chooses, he may quietly bow his head during a student-led, student-initiated prayer in deference and respect to students' religious beliefs and practices.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
