Subject: Motorcyclist Profiling Training For Peace Officers

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LAW ENFORCE/OFFICERS EN +\$31,000 GF EX See Note Provides relative to motorcyclist profiling training for peace officers

<u>Proposed law</u> directs the the council to include motorcyclist profiling awareness training in the current Bias Recognition Policing curriculum. <u>Proposed law</u> provides for training shall consist of at least one-half hour of classroom or internet instruction, or a combination of classroom and internet instruction.

EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

<u>Proposed law</u> will result in an SGF expenditure increase for the Louisiana Commission on Law Enforcement to include motorcyclist profiling awareness training in the current Bias Recognition Policing curriculum online or classroom. The agency reports that it will be necessary to contract out the redesign of the bias recognition curriculum to include the profile training. An RFP would be formulated to seek technical and professional assistance in that development. The cost of the assistance could range from \$1500 up to \$3,000 depending on the extent of the content that the POST Council deems necessary. The classroom version using classroom instructors would be ideal for the basic training curriculum and the online training would be better suited for the existing 23,000 peace officers statewide. The costs for an online training module would include a one-time development and implementation cost of approximately \$28,000 based on past experience of developing training modules for POST. This production costs is in addition to the redesign of the curriculum. Based on past experience with online training courses, the module should be periodically updated every 3-5 years.

REVENUE EXPLANATION

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental revenues as a result of this measure.
