

Existing law provides for an annual noncritical off-road equipment permit to be issued by the Dept. of Transportation and Development (DOTD) for vehicles or combinations of vehicles without booster units, or vehicles with a single-single, single-tandem, or tandem-tandem axle configuration in which no single axle is in excess of 30,000 pounds nor tandem axles in excess of 54,000 pounds.

New law includes single-triple axles not in excess of 30,000 pounds and triple axles not in excess of 54,000 pounds in the list of vehicles eligible for such permits.

Effective August 1, 2013.
