Provides relative to acceptable methods of payment for the office of motor vehicles

Present law authorizes the Department of Public Safety and Corrections, Public Safety Services, Office of Motor Vehicles (OMV) to accept credit cards, charge cards, and debit cards as payment for fees, fines, taxes, penalties, and interest. Proposed law provides that OMV shall accept credit cards, charge cards, and debit cards as payment for fees, fines, taxes, penalties, and interest. Proposed law exempts OMV from accepting credit cards for the International Registration Plan (IRP).
