Prior law required non-gaming suppliers who furnish goods or services in excess of \$200,000 per year to a gaming operator or slot machine or riverboat gaming licensee to obtain a non-gaming supplier permit issued by the La. Gaming Control Board.

New law removes the threshold amount of \$200,000 and requires the La. Gaming Control Board to establish through the promulgation of rules a threshold amount of goods and services for which a non-gaming supplier permit is required.

Effective August 1, 2018.
