## ACT 170 (HB 529)

<u>Prior law</u> prohibited a person holding a retail dealer's permit from permitting the illegal sale, offering for sale, possession, or permitting the consumption of any type of *narcotic or habit forming drug* on the premises of certain alcoholic beverage outlets.

<u>Existing law</u> prohibits a person holding a retail dealer's permit from permitting the illegal sale, offering for sale, possession, or permitting the consumption of any type of *controlled dangerous substances* on the premises of certain alcoholic beverage outlets.

<u>New law</u> retains <u>existing law</u> as it pertains to prohibiting a person holding a retail dealer's permit from permitting the illegal sale, offering for sale, possession, or permitting the consumption of any type of *controlled dangerous substance* on the premises. <u>New law</u> expands the prohibition to include *all other illegal substances*.

Effective August 1, 2018.
