WEAPONS/FIREARMS EN NO IMPACT See Note Page 1 of 1  
Provides relative to the carrying of concealed firearms by qualified retired law enforcement officers

Current law (La. R.S. 40:1379.1.4(B)(5)) permits an individual who is a qualified retired law enforcement officer (QRLEO) to carry a concealed firearm anywhere in the state, including anywhere in the public, if certain criteria are met, including qualifying annually for Peace Officers Standards and Training (P.O.S.T.) Council qualification.

Proposed law amends the definition of QRLEO to require that a law enforcement officer either qualify annually in the use of firearms by the P.O.S.T. Council and have proof of that certification or hold the P.O.S.T. Council qualification at the time of retirement in accordance with La. R.S. 40:1379.3(D)(1)(f) (which acknowledges his competence with a handgun). Proposed law provides that an individual who is retired from service as a QRLEO is not permitted to carry a concealed firearm in another state without proper qualification under the provisions of 18 U.S.C. 926C.
