HB 797 2024 Regular Session Coates

PUBLIC CONTRACT/BIDS: Prohibits a hospital service district from using "construction management at risk" for projects estimated to cost less than two million dollars.

DIGEST

<u>Present law</u> prohibits "construction management at risk" (CMAR) from being used for any project that is estimated to cost less than \$5,000,000.

<u>Proposed law</u> adds an exception for hospital service districts as defined by <u>present law</u>, which may not use CMAR for projects that cost less than \$2,000,000.

(Amends R.S. 38:2225.2.4(A)(3))

Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

The Committee Amendments Proposed by <u>House Committee on Transportation</u>, <u>Highways and Public Works</u> to the <u>original</u> bill:

1. Remove the requirement in <u>present law</u> for House and Senate transportation, highways and public works committee review and approval for CMAR projects costing between \$5,000,000 and \$15,000,000.

Committee Amendments Proposed by Senate Committee on Transportation, Highways, and Public Works to the engrossed bill

1. Restores the requirement in <u>present law</u> for House and Senate transportation, highways and public works committee review and approval for CMAR projects costing between \$5,000,000 and \$15,000,000.
