EN NO IMPACT See Note Provides relative to rural broadband high-speed internet access. (Item #31) (gov sig)

Proposed legislation grants the authority to rural electric cooperatives to grant permission of the use of their servitudes and their electric delivery system to a broadband service provider in order to provide broadband services to rural areas. Proposed legislation requires each Louisiana rural electric cooperative, the Louisiana Cable & Telecommunications Association, and the Louisiana Telecommunications Association to submit an annual written report to the Senate Committee on Commerce, Consumer Protection and International Affairs and the House of Representatives Committee on Commerce regarding the progress each cooperative has made in deploying broadband services to its members.
