SCHOOLS EGF NO IMPACT See Note Page 1 of 1
Provides relative to funding for university lab schools. (gov sig)

Present law provides that an elementary or secondary school operated by a public postsecondary institution (lab school) is considered part of the parish school system for the purpose of inclusion in the minimum foundation program. Requires the Department of Education (LDE) to allocate funds to the public postsecondary institution which shall allocate the funds for the operation of the lab school. Recognizes lab schools at LSU A&M, Southern A&M, and University of Louisiana at Lafayette (ULL).

Proposed law deletes reference to university laboratory schools operated by LSU A&M, Southern A&M, and the University of Louisiana at Lafayette. Provides that any elementary or secondary school operated by a four-year public postsecondary institution shall be considered a public elementary or secondary school for purposes of funding university laboratory schools through the MFP.

EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental expenditures as a result of this measure.

REVENUE EXPLANATION

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental revenues as a result of this measure.

The current MFP formula (SCR 2 of 2021) provides direct funding to LSU A&M and Southern A&M for the operation of laboratory schools. Other laboratory schools across the state are associated with universities and students are considered enrolled at their local school boards for purposes of MFP funding; however, the LFO does not have information on the specific agreements between the universities and the school boards to verify the entity responsible for the operation of the other laboratory schools. To the extent LSU A&M and Southern A&M are the only four-year universities that are considered to operate laboratory schools, and hence eligible to receive direct funding through the MFP, there is no impact as a result of the proposed bill.
